<b>Division Reports</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Community Health Report</li> </ul>		<p>Immunization clinic -- Have been full with standard immunization as the focus for school age children to meet regulation standards for attendance.</p> <p>COVID CLINICS -- Bivalent vaccine has been introduced for COVID clinics in both Genesee and Orleans County. Fair number have been vaccinated.</p> <p>Maternal child Health. Has been slow with referrals. One of our Nurse's will attend a child health class for perinatal and mood disorder in November.</p> <p>TB Orleans – down to two active cases &amp; three LTBI cases. Genesee – No active cases at this time.</p>	

	<p>Migrant outreach Orleans – Nursing &amp; staffing are going out twice a week to provide the Flu &amp; bivalent vaccine.</p> <p>Communicable disease – Orleans – One salmonella case that was investigated matched other cases in the westerner region. The State Health Department has been reinter-viewing the cases in the Western part of the State to see if there was a common food source or link. They currently have not identified anything. This process is ongoing.</p> <p>Have been busy with other programs outside of COVID.</p>

Introduced Darren Brodie -- New Environmental Health Director.</p> <p>We have been awarded a second HUD Grant funding. Previous grant was for \$1million plus \$300,000 for healthy homes for Genesee &amp; Orleans. This Second grant is for \$2.13 million in lead funds for the GLOW region (Genesee, Livingston, Orleans, &amp; Wyoming Counties) plus an additional \$325,000 for healthy homes for the next 4years.</p> <p>Healthy Neighborhoods program –Grant funded through NYSDOH To address door to door home safety issues. Currently only for the city of Batavia – if it goes well – will look into expanding.</p> <p>Sanitarian has been hired for Genesee – Karen Schmitt</p> <p>Rabies: in August &amp; September</p>

However we are showing improvement in other categories like preventable Hospital stays and sexually transmitted infections have gone down. Flu vaccination has gone up and alcohol impaired Driving has gone down. In Orleans HIV prevalence has gone down. Broad band access has gone up.

There is still a lot of work that needs to be done along with Health education and promoting health programs. The hope is to see the health indicators change as we shift from the pandemic to other programs.

Received the Space cat grant. Focus is on adverse childhood experiences (ACES) and how it intersects with suicide and overdose deaths. Our Work plan has committed to do a trauma and resiliency training Conference on November 9<sup>th</sup> 2022 at Batavia Downs.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Director's Report</li> </ul>	<p><b>Staffing updates:</b></p> <p>Orleans Vacant nursing position. Problematic as we will be losing some of our PT. nurses soon. Still looking for a sanitarian as well.</p> <p>Genesee currently looking to fill an epidemiology position &amp; a Lab coordinator/sanitarian.</p> <p><b>PHAB:</b> Still moving forward. We have received 100% of our examples (332) have been reviewed by the doc review committee (Scott, Carie &amp; Kristine.)</p> <p>Currently at 93.98% of examples have been reviewed and marked complete. Just over 6% remain to be tweaked or resubmitted. 46.69% have been reviewed and uploaded to EPHAB.</p> <p>Final reviews will continue through November with a deadline of the end of November to get all of the documents uploaded.</p> <p>Still waiting for the Updated EPHAB system to be released. There is currently a delay.</p> <p>Thank you to Fellows Lily, &amp; Megan, also to our intern Andy for their help with this process.</p>	

MRC grant will be used to update the GO Health App. To replace Orleans Aware and ready Genesee. The name will remain the same but the format/platform will be updated.

We will also be investing in an Inventory management system. To keep track of supplies electronically with in all of our different departmental programs such as Nursing, Environment and Emergency Preparedness.

COVID grant to purchase two RV's for vaccinations. One for Orleans (sprinter van) and Genesee (mobile unit 25-30ft). Currently out for bid(s).

Radon Grant (GC only)  
To help address radon issues.

HUD Grant to help expand our service areas. In conjunction with CDC and State Grants brings us to about \$5million in the lead program.

Healing Communities Grant  
In phase 2 of this process to use funds towards programs and staff. Focus on Narcan and focus on Access to care, with treatment opportunities in the next phases.

We would also like to start looking at an Overdose Fatality Review Committee to help target other initiatives going forward through reports and autopsy reviews.

Settlement funds from lawsuits that have come out; On committees to determine how the funds should be used; majority have to be used for overdose issues based on the restrictions outlined in

	<p>settlement. A bulk of the funds my go to GCASA who is our primary substance abuse provider. But are looking to fund some projects such as lock boxes.</p> <p>The 11.15 waiver aka District 2.0 is moving forward. The application has been submitted by the State to the Federal Government.</p> <p>CDC Public Health workforce funding. The application for this has gone in from the State. We should hear by the end of the month what the State should be getting. We should receive some initial funding/allocations to the counties at about 550 to 600,000 range Genesee being a little more... to be dispersed over 5yrs. To be used for PH recruitment and retention purposes. Speaking with County managers and the Legislature regarding the funds and the purpose to reinvest back into PH and its workforce.</p>
